

# Project Report for Romy

## **Objectives:**

1. Build a shaded learning and relaxation area adjacent to the crèche and near the computer lab.
2. Address the lack of drinking water for learners at the crèche through a rainwater harvesting project.

## **Process:**

The above objectives were identified through a decision making process which included the school management, Romy and VA32.

### *Shaded Learning Area:*

Budgets were assessed and work on phase 1 was initiated before the departure of Romy back to Germany. After her departure the shaded learning and relaxation area were completed by volunteers and staff of VA32.

*The "rainwater harvesting" project:*

This project included

- Stripping off the old wooden facier boards which had serious wood rot.
- Repairing pole work and roof truss ends
- Replacing and painting facier boards
- Repainting side wall of the crèche
- Installing gutters and down pipes
- Building a water tank base
- Purchasing a 2500 litre water tank
- Installing the tank
- Fitting appropriate plumbing to have an internal drinking water tap situated in the crèche
